*Almost every one of the hundred and one lessons in this seminar contains a practice exercise; and many of those were created using a series of articles I wrote a few years ago for a local Christian newspaper about creation and the flood. A number of those articles were based on a series of lessons I created and taught to children when my husband and I taught a Creation Seminar at a local church at about that same time.*

*Why do I mention this? Well, in order to show you how the techniques work that are taught in any given lesson in this Word 101 Seminar, it was necessary to apply them to something—and it seemed best to use my own material in order to avoid any possible copyright infringement problems. In the interests of saving time, I decided not to write new material but to use these existing articles. I didn't have enough articles to use a unique one for each lesson, so I used each article several times—generally using one article per section. In any case, the articles are used in the proper order for reading them in sequence.*

*The content of the articles is not connected to the Word 101 Seminar in any way, so you need not read them. However, you are certainly welcome to do so—and also to use them (to convey their intended messages) if you think they will be helpful. (Just delete the lesson material.) If you appreciate teachings on Creation and Noah's Flood you will have received an added bonus. If you don't, then do not read the articles—just observe how the Word techniques apply.*
